



Progress Report

22nd May 2015

The highlights of our progress since Easter are listed below:

- Pupil interviews show the children have a wider range of strategies to help them work independently.
- Children are able to distinguish different subjects within a topic much more clearly.
- Monitoring shows that intervention groups have a positive effect on pupil progress.
- Book checks show that next steps marking and 'fix-it' time are becoming established in English and Maths.
- Children are able to talk about their 'Learning to Learn' skills.
- Data analysis shows that many children in receipt of PPG are making faster progress and closing the attainment gap.
- Children are able to name and describe our Christian values.
- Set the school budget in order to maintain our capacity to improve
- Our 'Take-a-Break' sessions on a Wednesday have been very successful with many parents signing up for additional courses.
- Our work with the Children's Centre has widened to include e-safety workshops, the Actions & Consequences programme in addition to family support and Lion's Quest.

Next steps:

- Establish 'fix-it' time across the curriculum.
- Identify a strategy to maintain the rate of continuing development whilst guarding well-being.
- Confirm the staffing structure for 2015/16.
- Analyse our end of year data and communicate this to our HMI
