We will be.....

Mathematics

We will be.....
Estimating how many in total and checking using accurate counting.
Finding how many more and less than a given number.
Ordering numerals 0-20.
Problem solving using numbers 0-20-finding ways to record what we know.
Writing number sentences using +, - and =
We will look at time and how we measure this.

Physical Development

We will use a knife to butter bread and cut sandwiches!
Forming long ladder letters and one armed robot letters correctly.
Writing numerals correctly.
We will be using scissors and other tools with increasing control.
Developing control, coordination and agility with Enjoy a Ball Paul.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be painting, sticking, drawing, sculpting (playdough) and using construction kits (such as Lego) to express our ideas.
We will be listening and responding to a variety of music.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Is Goldilocks a good friend? Are the ugly sisters? Who are our friends? What qualities do they have?
What can the Billy Goats say to the troll to make him be kinder?
We will be considering how Cinderella feels when she is poorly treated. How could we cheer her up?

Through play, we will continue to develop the skills needed to negotiate with friends, take turns and share fairly.
