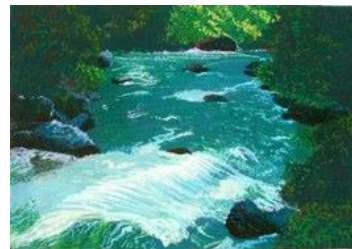

### Famous scientists
