

Communication & Language

We will work in our key people groups to develop our listening skills. We will communicate with friends when playing, becoming good listeners and talkers.

Literacy

We will enjoy a variety of stories like Percy the Park Keeper and Owl Babies. We will learn some poems and share these with others. In small groups we will talk about what we've read and show we understand it.

Daily phonics sessions will introduce us to many new letter sounds and we will begin to blend these to read words and segment them to write.

Mathematics

We will look at numbers 0-5, learning about place value, sorting amounts into groups, comparing quantities and finding 1 more and 1 less.

We will also explore the concept of time.

Physical Development

Enjoy a Ball Paul will be taking our PE session on a Tuesday afternoon. Through a fun and action packed programme of activities we will develop our fundamental movement skills.

We will complete daily 'Busy Fingers' challenges. These will help strengthen our hands and fingers for writing.

We will learn how to form the letters in our name correctly.
