- Narrative

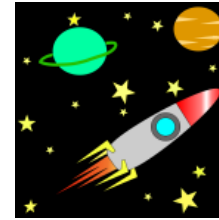
## SPAG

Children will be focusing on different word classes and their functions:

- Nouns, including noun phrases,

- Verbs, including imperative verbs,
- Adverbs for manner and place,
- Devices to build cohesion within a paragraph, e.g. firstly, then, presently, subsequently.
- Audience awareness.

## Maths

- Place value to at least 1 million
- Roman numerals
- Adding and subtracting, including decimals
- Mental strategies for multiplication and division.
- Doubling and halving.
- Multiplication and division, up to 4 digits x 2 digit
- Multiply and divide numbers by 10/100/1000
- Comparing and ordering fractions.
